Getting started and reaching your target maintenance dose

TYVASO DPI™ (treprostinil) is a small, portable inhaler that uses prefilled cartridges and features a simple-to-use design.

Use this guide to learn about taking TYVASO DPI, the titration process, and why reaching your target maintenance dose is important.

What is titration?

Compact and easy to bring with you

TYVASO DPI (treprostinil) Inhalation Powder quickly delivers medicine to the site of disease, where it's needed. This portable inhaler allows for dosing at home or on the go.

TYVASO DPI comes with prefilled, single-dose cartridges and does not require cleaning or charging.

- Plan for treatment sessions 4x daily (approximately every 4 waking hours)
- Doses are taken in 1 breath per cartridge
- Replace your inhaler every 7 days

Reaching your target maintenance dose

- When starting TYVASO DPI, you may begin with a titration phase. During this time, your doctor will work with you to develop a plan to gradually increase your dose until you reach your target maintenance dose
- Depending on how you respond to treatment, your doctor may also lower your dose at times during the titration phase

Why is it important to reach your target maintenance dose?

Your target maintenance dose will help you get the full benefit of your medicine. Through the titration process, you'll still take your prescribed dose 4x daily, as directed by your doctor.



How to titrate TYVASO DPI

Which cartridge should you use?

Adjusting your dose

Your doctor will work with you to increase your dose until you reach your target maintenance dose. If you experience side effects, reach out to your nurse or doctor. Do not stop taking TYVASO DPI without talking to your healthcare provider.

Most people start with the **16 mcg cartridge**, **4x daily**, and **increase** the cartridge strength every **1-2 weeks** until they reach their target maintenance dose.



Reaching your target maintenance dose allows you to get the full benefit of your medicine.

Titration kits are available

There are titration kits available for TYVASO DPI that can help make the process of starting and titrating your treatment easier. Each kit contains a carrying case, and a number of inhalers and medicine cartridges that are tailored to your current stage of treatment, including an extra inhaler in case it is needed.



Use the right cartridge for your prescribed dose

Cartridge colors

Cartridges are color-coded based on their specific doses.







Green is 64 mcg



Single-cartridge dosing

For most doses, you will need just 1 cartridge. For example, if you're prescribed 16 mcg for each session, you may use:





Multiple-cartridge dosing

If you're prescribed a dose higher than 64 mcg, you may need 2 cartridges. For example, if prescribed 80 mcg, you may use:

> 1 dark blue cartridge (32 mcg)





1 light blue cartridge (48 mcg)



Always take your medicine as prescribed. If you are unsure about your dose, check with your healthcare provider.



You may have side effects...

Don't let side effects stop you from getting the benefits of your medicine.

It's important to talk to your healthcare provider and continue taking TYVASO DPI unless told to stop. Be sure to contact your nurse about things you can do to help manage side effects while continuing treatment, such as:

COUGH/THROAT IRRITATION

- Review proper technique
- Before treatment, drink very cold or very warm water
- If needed, use a throat spray to numb your throat before treatment
- Talk to your healthcare provider to see if slowing the pace at which you increase your dose could help

NAUSEA

- Rinse your mouth with water after treatment
- Talk to your healthcare provider to see if slowing the pace at which you increase your dose could help

HEADACHE

Use an over-the-counter pain reliever, like acetaminophen; talk to your healthcare provider to see if slowing the pace at which you increase your dose could help
